Last day for military or overseas voters to register to vote, to request a vote-by-mail ballot, and to send it to the county

elections official.

**CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION PERIOD: During** 

the period 14 days prior to Election Day and including Election Day, an individual can go to the office of his/her county elections official to conditionally register to vote and vote a provisional ballot. § 2170

January 15, 2019 through January 29, 2019 (E-14 – 0) NEW CITIZEN REGISTRATION PERIOD: A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of the county elections official at any time beginning on January 15, 2019 and ending at the close of polls on January 29, 2019.

A new citizen registering to vote after the close of registration shall provide the county elections official with proof of citizenship prior to voting and shall declare that he or she has established residency in California.

§§ 331, 3500, 3501

The ballots of new citizens shall be received and canvassed at the same time and under the same procedure as vote-by-mail voter ballots. § 3502

January 15, 2019 (E-14) VOTE-BY-MAIL BOARDS COMMENCE TO PROCESS

VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS: Processing of vote-by-mail ballots may begin on the tenth business day prior to the election. Processing vote-by-mail ballots includes opening vote-by-mail ballot return envelopes, removing ballots, duplicating any damaged ballots, and preparing ballots to be machine read, but under no circumstances may a vote count be accessed or released until 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

January 19, 2019 (E-10) **NOTICE OF ELECTION:** The Registrar of Voters must publish once in a newspaper of general circulation the notice that ballots will be counted in a central location. § 12109

RETURNS: The Registrar of Voters will begin the official canvass of the precinct returns. § 15301

February 28, 2019 (E+30) COMPLETE CANVASS OF OFFICIAL RETURNS AND CERTIFY RESULTS BY THIS DATE: No later than this date, the county elections official must complete the canvass and certify its results. § 15372
